## Class Concerns

### December 2018

- M3 – See below for “Toledo students” concern.
  - Students concerned about cost of in-hospital injuries covered by various hospitals. All insurance companies that NEOMED students have must cover exposure expenses. There is a strict exposure policy in place. Financial aid office can help with deductibles of medical expenses. Dr. Mowad can provide more specific information in terms of policies at different sites.
  - Mental health concerns for M3s during rotations. NEOMED counseling connects with Coleman Behavioral Services outside of normal hours for those not on campus. NEOMED insurance covers TelaDoc.
- P3 – Liebelt is very cold.
- M2 – Acronyms of student organizations are vague in emails to student events list serves.
- P2 – Vending machines by Liebelt are still empty. Healthy food is requested.
- M1 – Students are overwhelmed with number of student event emails per day. As of now, Harmony will send an email regarding instructions over break on how to filter emails from Student Events.
  - **Possible Constitution Amendment:** Student events must be open to all students. There are more student organizations which may require two student list servers (medicine and pharmacy) for emails in the future. For next year, students will be defaulted to receive emails from their own school. They can opt to receive emails from both schools by contacting Harmony. Student events that pertain to both schools will be able to access both list servers. They will still be able to filter emails as well.
- P1 –
  - The library is cold.
  - Many lights are out and some are flickering in Olson.
    - **Fixed!**
  - Medical problems to miss an exam/time off during a semester, interested if there is a course of action where they would not have to redo the year.
    - Don't deter an individual from taking a leave of absence
    - Module system to prevent having to redo the year is possible
