

ABOUT ALPHA OMEGA ALPHA

The Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society was founded by William Webster Root and five medical students at the College of Physicians and Surgeons in Chicago in the year 1902, and is the only national honor medical society in the world. As stated in the society's constitution, "Alpha Omega Alpha is organized for educational purposes exclusively and not for profit, and its aim shall be the promotion of scholarship and research in medical schools, the encouragement of a high standard of character and conduct among medical students and graduates, and the recognition of high attainment in medical science, practice, and related fields." Election to Alpha Omega Alpha is a distinction that accompanies a physician throughout his or her career. Members can be elected as students, graduates, or faculty of an affiliated institution, or because of distinguished achievement in any field, or an honorary basis. Chapters elect undergraduate members from students in their last two years of medical school. Scholastic excellence is not the only criterion for election; integrity, capacity for leadership, compassion, and fairness in dealing with one's colleagues are considered to be of equal significance, and the number of students elected from any class may not exceed one-sixth of those expected to graduate. The students elected to the society are men and women who, in the judgment of the local chapter, have shown promise of becoming leaders in their profession.
