



Downing Urban Health MD Scholarship Application

The purpose of the Downing Urban Health MD Scholarship is to provide a fourth year medicine student in the NEOMED-CSU Partnership for Urban Health program with a \$10,000 scholarship. Recipients must match in a primary care residency training program. Primary care is defined as Family Medicine, Pediatrics, or Internal Medicine.

M4 NEOMED-CSU Partnership for Urban Health students who plan on matching in primary care are encouraged to apply for this scholarship opportunity. Up to three students will be awarded a \$10,000 scholarship. Immediately following match day, the Scholarship and Awards Committee will review the applications for those applicants that did match in Family Medicine, Pediatrics, or Internal Medicine.

Applicants must be in good academic standing and demonstrate a financial need. All applicants must have a 2017-2018 FAFSA on file with NEOMED. Calculation for financial need is Cost of Attendance minus Expected Family Contribution equals Financial Need. If Financial Need is a positive number, then a financial need has been demonstrated. Applicants can contact Financial Aid if they are unsure if they demonstrate a financial need.
