Current Business

NSC updates:

- Dr. Zarconi – Student mental health is being moved from Student Affairs to Health Affairs within the University. Health affairs agenda is mostly related to outside partnerships as well as health issues such as the Student Run Free Clinic. This more clearly separates the seeking of mental health services away from student affairs which deals with academic records. This transition will initiate at the beginning of July. Student services will not be eliminated in any fashion. Two students are on the Steering Committee that is leading this change. Student input on the transition and services provided is encouraged. One of the goals of this change and request for input is to encourage students who need mental health care to seek that help.
- Chris Mette – Conference services is NEOMED organized but is self-operational. They handle all of their own operations. Conference Services is the license holder for the entire university. This list includes all food brought on to campus from an outside source. The idea is to streamline the process, work with students, and gain student trust/cooperation. The idea is that "The List" is modified only once per year. Need to eliminate mid-year modifications. Students requesting restaurants to be added to the list of vendors are required to obtain a copy of the licenses held by that restaurants. The main focus to fix is mid-year add-ons and obtaining of restaurant licenses. This May, NSC will finalize a list for the following year, which will be modified once a year.
