## Current Business



- **NSC Updates:**
- Please welcome new Associate Dean of Medical Education in the College of Medicine Dr. Ryan Palmer. He is a strong believer in student/faculty/staf interaction, pledges to be extraordinarily present, and is a strong advocate for social learning, group interactions, and technology implementation into education. He encourages students to reach out to him and looks to demonstrate the value of the curriculum at NEOMED and find a wholistic solution to the issues at hand.
- No July Meeting is planned due to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday.
- The following amendments were made to the NSC constitution:
  - Multiple presentations at the same conference cannot exceed 1000\$. The total allotted funding for a presentation is 1000\$.
  - Conditional funding approval can be provided given that official acceptance to the conference may not always be provided in the correct timeframe. Students must request funding at the proper NSC meeting based on the date of the presentation and provide conference acceptance notice to NSC to secure their funds.
  - All people involved in a presentation submit separate requests. Monies can be split amongst the parties involved as they see fit and should be reflected in their individual requests.
  - The treasurer now has the added responsibility of tracking funding on a month-to-month basis over time.
  - NSC has provided student organizations with a dedicated room, adequate shelving, as well as individual numbered storage bins for each student group.
  - Student organizations may utilize these bins for storage of flatware, paper plates, bottled water, etc., as they see fit.
  - Student organizations will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of this area and ensuring their bin is placed in the correct location.
  - The storage room will be inspected by NSC intermittently, at least once a month.
  - Student organizations found to have materials out of place may see future NSC event funding affected.

- Students no longer must submit a report to the NSC via email to the current president or at an NSC meeting must be made within 30 days of returning from the conference.
