The CRAFT program at Cleveland Clinic Akron General (CCAG) is an eight-week summer experience for rising second-year medical students seeking early, hands-on clinical exposure across a variety of specialties.

Students work with CCAG physicians and scientists through lectures, independent learning, and department-based research projects.
