RISE PharmD Student Education Scholarships help the next generation of compounding pharmacists pursue their education and make a lasting impact on patient care.

What is the scholarship?

The RISE PharmD Student Education Scholarship helps remove financial barriers to advanced compounding education. Whether you're attending a workshop, conference, lab course, or certificate program, the scholarship supports the knowledge and hands-on skills you need to become a leader in compounding pharmacy.



Is this scholarship right for you?

- ✓ I am a pharmacy student currently enrolled in a PharmD program.
- ✓ I want compounding education beyond my required curriculum.
- ✓ The program I am considering focuses on compounding education.
- ✓ The training supports my learning, career goals, or interest in patient care.
- ✓ I understand the scholarship does not cover pharmacy school tuition, required coursework, or school-mandated electives.
- ✓ I can provide basic program details, cost estimates, school information, and an unofficial transcript.

What Your Scholarship Covers

If selected, recipients receive an award based on available funding and the cost of the approved education or training program. The standard maximum award is up to \$2,000 per recipient per year. Items eligible for reimbursement are limited to the following:

Program Fees

Covered for all eligible recipients. RISE pays approved program costs directly to the provider.

Airfare

Up to \$500 when a student must fly to a program outside their city of residence.

Hotel/Lodging

Up to \$400 total (\$200 per night; maximum of 2 nights) for eligible travel.

Incidentals Stipend

Optional one-time \$100 stipend for in-person programs; elected at the time of application.

Important Note: If your program is in your city of residence, RISE will cover your program fees only.

Explore Eligible Programs

Eligible programs are not limited to one provider or format. RISE welcomes seminars, conferences, workshops, hands-on training, and courses that align with the mission of advancing compounding pharmacy practice and education.

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Before You Apply...

- ✓ Choose the compounding education or training program you plan to attend.
- ✓ Gather provider, course name, location or format, and fees.
- ✓ Confirm whether the program is located within your city or area of residence.
- ✓ Prepare a personal statement focused on mission alignment, growth, leadership, and service.
- ✓ Confirm it is independent from and in addition to required PharmD coursework. Estimate airfare and hotel travel costs (if applicable).
- ✓ Have your school details, graduation date, and unofficial transcript ready.
